

## Instructions on how to use Citizens Request for Action (CRA)

Citizens Request for Action (CRA) is a way citizens can request a number of services performed by the City online, and have a method to track the progress of their request. From the link on the City website, the citizen is taken to the screen that will allows them to create a new request for service.



Once their request is submitted they are given a request number that they may use to track the status of their request at any time by go back through the link and selecting "Look Up Request" and entering their request number.




After entering their request number they can view the status of the request, and any progress that has been made towards resolving their issue. They may also view any notes regarding the request by clicking on resolution button in the action history.
