

## 2018 Calls for Service and Use of Force

Calls for Service

Officers interact with citizens in numerous ways. In 2018, we responded to 28,945 calls for service.

Arrests

Officers took **1847** arrestees into custody in 2018.

Vehicle Pursuits

Officers were involved in **22** pursuits in 2018. This equates to **0.07**% of the total calls for service.

Use of Force

Officers were required to use force **89** times in 2018. This equates to **0.30**% of the total calls for service\*.

\*Reported instances are defined as: instances where an arrestee forces an officer to safely initiate physical contact with a subject, control a subject and/or move a subject in a controlled way.

Hate Crimes

Officers responded to **0** hate crimes in 2018\*.

\*Hate Crime is defined as: threats, harassment, or physical harm and is motivated by prejudice against someone's race, color, religion, national origin, ethnicity, sexual orientation or physical or mental disability.

Use of Deadly Force

Officers were forced to use such a level of force 1 times in 2018\*.

\*Deadly Force is defined as: The intentional use of a firearm or other instrument, the use of which would result in a high probability of death.
