2. Approval of Minutes from February 13, 2019 Personnel Committee meeting

Alderman Duchniak made a motion to approve the minutes of January 9, 2018; seconded by Alderman Gehl. All ave; motion carried.

3. Request to fill vacant Building/Plumbing Inspector position in the Building Inspection Division

Inspection Manager Jeffrey Lynch gave the Committee background information on the vacancy and the current staffing need. The vacancy is due to the upcoming retirement of Edward Ciechanowski who has 32 years in the Engineering Department. It was suggested that maybe in the future a regional look at the inspectors' position as it relates to salary maybe warranted. However, for now we will post the position based on the current salary range of \$65,516 to \$72,653.
