# Purpose and Background

Arthur Abendschein Park is one of two of Oak Creek's Community parks and is named after Oak Creek's First Mayor. The park is centrally located within the City of Oak Creek, east of S Howell Avenue and south of Drexel Avenue. The park is surrounded by residential neighborhoods and a few remnant large, rural lot residences and farms. The 75-acre Abendschein Park provides an abundance of opportunities for visitors, including: a skatepark, a hardball field with practice mounds and batting cages, an 18-hole disc golf course, an open-air shelter, a playground, multi-use trails, a concessions/ restroom facility and a cricket pitch.

The City's first Community Park Master Plan was adopted for Abendschein Park in 2000, three phases of the project have been implemented so far. The recent redevelopment of Lake Vista Park along Lake Michigan has prompted to City to re-evaluate the previous plan for Abendschein and determine what residents would like to see in the park and what amenities would be feasible, understanding that there are wetlands in the park. This current master plan update will identify issues and opportunities for the future development of Abendschein Park.

# 2 Goals and Intended Outcomes

The overall goals of the PPP are to:

- Use a variety of outreach techniques to make it easy for everybody to participate in the planning process, focusing on going to the public and meeting stakeholder groups where they are.
- Use innovative engagement methods and a variety of online and in-person platforms to reach more individuals and groups typically underserved in community planning engagement efforts.
- Share information in an open, accessible, and timely manner.
- Guide the development of Plan objectives and implementation strategies through timely and relevant community feedback.
- Convey the importance and relevance of the Park Master Plan to Oak Creek's stakeholders.
- Build community support for Plan objectives.

The success of this PPP will be the extent to which stakeholders have actively participated in the planning process and helped to shape the outcomes of the Abendschein Park Master Plan. A secondary outcome is that there will be broad buy-in and ownership of the policy, design, and investment direction set for Abendschein Park, through the master plan.

## **Stakeholders**

A stakeholder is generally defined as a person, group or organization with a specific interest in a plan. A broad list of stakeholders has been developed for this master plan process. Additional stakeholders may continue to be included as the planning process evolves and as specific needs are identified. It is understood that not every stakeholder shares the same level of interest or commitment to the planning process. As a result, it is important to offer opportunities across the spectrum of involvement, including:

- **Inform**: to provide accessible, objective information to assist stakeholders and the public in understanding the planning process and its relevance to their lives
- Coordinate: to share resources and expertise
- Consult: to consider the views, actions or information from others prior to taking action
- Cooperate: to work together to achieve a common goal or objective

Specific groups of stakeholders and their targeted level of involvement in this Plan are described below. Additional stakeholders may continue to emerge throughout this process. They will be made to feel welcome and every effort will be made to help them understand the current stage of the planning process and empower them to participate in a meaningful way.

### City of Oak Creek

City staff plays a critical role in implementing park development and programming through day-today decision-making. It is important that Oak Creek employees be engaged in the master planning process, so they develop buy-in and support for the final plan. City staff will be responsible for the ongoing implementation of the plan.

### **City Council**

The City's elected leaders have a critical role in implementing the goals and policies of the Abendschein Park Master Plan through subsequent Council actions. The City Council ultimately approves the City's budget and spending priorities as set forth in the Master Plan.

### Parks, Recreation, and Forestry Commission

The Parks, Recreation, and Forestry Commission is the body charged by law with developing regulations and a capital budget for the improvement and operation of parks in Oak Creek. The Abendschein Park Master Plan is an important document to guide this work.

### **Partners**

Oak Creek's agency partners will play a key role in helping the City to develop toward its desired future. These include Milwaukee County, officials in adjacent communities, and state agencies responsible for land use management, natural resources, and parks and open space. These groups are considered partners, since they play an important role in planning and developing a strong community and park system in Oak Creek.

### Public

As the ultimate beneficiary of planning outcomes, the general public is a key audience the City of Oak Creek intends to reach through the Abendschein Park Master Plan. The interest of a member of the general public may be less specific than that of another stakeholder group, but is no less important. Those with any level of interest should have the opportunity to learn about the Master Plan and provide input. Oak Creek and the consultant team will employ a variety of outreach techniques with the goal of reaching a broad audience. Oak Creek will also provide specific outreach opportunities for traditionally underserved populations by creating pop-up and online engagement opportunities that are highly visual and understandable for participants of all ages and language skills. These targeted populations include ethnic or racial minority groups, low wage earners, non-English speakers, elderly, youth, and persons with disabilities.

# 4 Project Advisory Structure

## Working Group

The City of Oak Creek will convene a Working Group to provide input at every stage of the Plan's development. The make-up of the group will include diverse community stakeholders. The purpose of the working group is to create an opportunity for intentional participation among a committed and focused group of community representatives. They will provide input on every stage of the Master Plan's development and develop a thorough understanding of the vision, goals, and implementation strategies for Abendschein Park. The working group is intended to serve as the champions of the planning process who can share information with other members of the community and serve as liaisons to bring community input into the planning process.

This group is comprised of members of the Parks, Recreation, and Forestry Commission, City Staff, and Alderman.

## City Council

The Oak Creek City Council must adopt the updated master plan, and ultimately has the authority to implement the final master plan. The City of Oak Creek will brief the City Council at monthly meetings and via periodic e-mail updates at key stages of the project. Aldermen will also be able to follow the project on the project website and social media.

# 6 Project Phases

There are a number of phases to developing a park master plan. The type of outreach and the audiences targeted vary with each phase. Opportunities for all stakeholders to participate will be available throughout the planning process. The following list identifies project stages and summarizes the type of outreach to occur during each phase:

- **Background, Context, and Vision**: This phase includes identification of key issues to be addressed through the Abendschein Park Master Plan. This phase will include internal research and analysis as well as key meetings with city staff and the working group.
- Detailed Analysis and Programming: This phase will focus on in-depth engagement and research on the issues and opportunities facing the park. Engagement strategies in phase two include a pop-up public event, a working group meeting, focus group meetings, and social media updates.
- **Draft Updated Master Plans**: This phase summarizes the data collected in the first two phases and translates that information into draft alternatives (plans and illustrations). Like phase two, it will include an open house, a working group meeting, and social media updates.
- **Refined Master Plan Alternative**: Project staff will refine the master plan, and prepare cost estimates and a phasing plan as part of this phase of the project. Community engagement will consist of meetings with elected officials and social media updates.
- **Final Master Plan**: The final phase of the planning process includes the development and adoption of the final master plan for Abendschein Park. Stakeholders will be able to provide feedback and comments on the final plan in an open house, working group meeting, and official hearings.

# 6 Outreach Techniques

The following list describes the core public outreach techniques that will be employed during the master planning process. The techniques include both in-person and on-line engagement activities to maximize opportunities for participation. At any point in the project, a group may request a presentation or a meeting with City staff to present their own ideas as an input opportunity beyond those that are specifically described below.

## In-Person Engagement Events

## Stakeholder Meetings (Focus Groups)

Consultant and City Staff will schedule informational meetings with stakeholder groups. The goal of these meetings is to increase overall project awareness and provide key information to stakeholders to help them understand the importance of the Abendschein Park Master Plan and its relevance to them, and to allow stakeholders the opportunity to share their ideas directly with staff.

### Site-Specific Outreach/Community Events (Pop-up Engagement)

The working group will identify retail destinations and community facilities and events and work with those properties to schedule pop-up engagement sessions at these locations. These may take the form of booths or kiosks with information about the Master Plan and opportunities to participate in surveys or questionnaires about key issues or plan priorities. The goal of these events is to reach individuals who do not normally participate in the planning process by making it easy and convenient. These activities will occur throughout the master planning process with a higher intensity early in the planning phases, when there is greater opportunity to influence project development.

In addition to workplace-based outreach, the working group will identify community events throughout the City for additional engagement sessions, including the Farmer's Market. The sessions will consist of information sharing and interactive exercises. A particular focus will be given to events that help reach traditionally underserved and hard-to-reach populations.

### **Public Open Houses**

Public open houses provide an in-person opportunity for stakeholders, including the general public, to come to an event hosted by the City of Oak Creek and have a conversation with project staff and elected officials. The City will host three open houses during this planning process. If possible, these events will be scheduled at local restaurants such as the BelAir Cantina. Hearty snacks will be provided to support relationship-building and an atmosphere of conviviality among participants. Depending on the expected level of participation, this could cost approximately \$250.

## **Online Engagement Tools**

For a community-wide effort with broad applicability, online engagement is critical to reaching a greater audience. For this reason, the engagement strategy for this planning process includes robust use of online tools. These tools will mirror those implemented in-person, allowing for consistent messaging and integration of project feedback.

### **Project Website**

The Abendschein Park Master Plan will have a dedicated website, linked on the City of Oak Creek's official website. This project website will serve as a hub for information, resources, and online engagement opportunities for the Master Plan. The website will serve as a repository of documents produced throughout the planning process, so that stakeholders can stay up-to-date with project development. It will include a calendar of events and opportunities to contact project staff with questions and feedback. Stantec staff will host and maintain the project website.

### Social Media

Social media will be used to promote engagement activities as part of the master planning process and to generate excitement about the project. Stantec will develop content advertising the master planning process for facebook, twitter, and Instagram. The ads will be highly graphic and formatted to fit an instagram post. The ads will also include pertinent project information that will be clear, easy to understand, and effective for e-readers (ADA accessible). The City of Oak Creek will post this content to their social media platforms and engage with participants by answering questions and respond to comments.

### Web Survey

Project staff, the working group, and City Council will gain feedback from the public on key issues affecting Abendschein Park using an interactive web survey. A brief, easy-to-use survey will be developed to gather this input via SurveyMonkey. The survey will be designed to include approximately ten multiple choice and free response questions, taking users approximately five minutes to complete.

### Stakeholder E-mail Updates

E-mail lists will be developed to provide updates to interested stakeholders. A link to sign up for the email list will be available on the project website. E-mails will be sent at key stages in the master planning process and will highlight recent discussions and upcoming opportunities for input. E-mail messaging will be succinct and branded to promote readership.

Evaluation of engagement techniques will be based on the following criteria.


## Quantitative

## Qualitative


- What kind of feedback was received from the in-person and online outreach?


## Q1 How often do you use Abendschein Park?

## Q3 What is your overall opinion of the park?




## Q5 What needs the most improvement in Abendschein Park? In other words, what would you change?


## Q6 Is the park usually clean when you visit?


## Q8 When you visit Abendschein Park, what activities do you or members of your household participate in? (Check all that apply)










## Q12 What is your age range?

## Q13 Does your household include children under 12 years old?





## Q14 What is your gender?


