I-94/PUETZ ROAD WATER MAIN CROSSING PROJECT CHANGE ORDER Commissioner Wille, with Commissioner Siepert seconding, made the motion to approve Change Order No. 1 for the I-94 and Puetz Road Water Main Crossing Project (Project 18108) to Globe Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$7,153.87. Roll call vote, all voted aye.

AWARD COLLEGE AVENUE WATER MAIN PROJECT Commissioner Richards, with Commissioner Cigale seconding, made the motion to approve the West College Avenue Water Main Extension Project (Project 19103) and award a construction contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Cornerstone One, based on the bid amount of \$406,414.00. Roll call vote, all voted aye.

AWARD HOWELL AVENUE/QUAIL RUN LOOPING WATER MAIN PROJECT Commissioner Siepert, with Commissioner Wille seconding, made the motion to approve the Howell Avenue and Quail Run Water Main Looping Project (Project 17103) and award a construction contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Cornerstone One, based on the bid amount of \$276,759.00. Roll call vote, all voted aye.

AMEND CAPITAL BUDGET FOR SANITARY SEWER MASTER PLAN Commissioner Wille, with Commissioner Siepert seconding, made the motion to amend the capital improvement budget in the amount of \$100,000.00 for the Sanitary Sewer Master Plan agreement with Brown and Caldwell. Roll call vote, all voted aye.

CHEMICAL BIDS

Commissioner Wille, with Commissioner Siepert seconding, made the motion to approve the recommended bids for the Utility's 2020 chemical needs as prepared by staff. Roll call vote, all voted aye.

PROJECT PAYMENT APPROVAL

Commissioner Wille, with Commissioner Cigale seconding, made the motion to approve Project Payment No. 3 (Final Payment) for the South 27th Street Water Main Extension Project (Project 18104) to Globe Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$23,663.40. Roll call vote, all voted aye.

Commissioner Siepert, with Commissioner Wille seconding, made the motion to approve Project Payment No. 5 (Final Payment) for the I-94 and Puetz Road Water Main Crossing Project (Project 18108) to Globe Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$70,395,49. Roll call vote, all voted aye.

UTILITY BILLING SOFTWARE UPGRADE APPROVAL Commissioner Gehl, with Commissioner Wille seconding, made the motion to authorize Accounting Supervisor Stenzel to enter into an agreement with Civic Systems, LLC for an upgrade to the Caselle Connect utility billing software in the amount of \$42,740.00. Roll call vote, all voted aye.
