With a nod to Oak Creek's agricultural roots, the *Oak Creek Farmers Market* offers the best of a classic farmer's market while being located in a contemporary community gathering space. Our wide-open market offers locally grown farm fresh foods, at their peak of freshness. Many of the farmers pick their produce in the morning and make it availably for the start of the 9 a.m. market in Oak Creek.

The market finished its sixth successful season during 2023! This city-run market has grown immensely popular due to the sustainable products, public health awareness, nutrition, and community education of access to local produce. After several years of successful 20-week seasons, we expanded the market to 24 weeks in 2022, which resulted in record sales and attendance for the season. We saw an increase of 100% in sales this year, making the *Oak Creek Farmers Market* the fastest growing market in the state.

Sponsorships are limited, but do include the opportunity for a booth at the market(s), as well as a list of ways you will get exposure for your brand. This is the only way a business can attend the market, we do not sell spaces unless you are a vendor selling a home made, home grown, or hand-made product.

PARTNERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

For 2024, the *Oak Creek Farmers Market* will be offering several partnership opportunities to continue the mission of the market. They include:

LIVE MUSIC

Visitors to the market love the live music each week. We invite local artists to play in the square each Saturday. Sponsorship covers the cost of this live music for the season.

NON-PROFIT SPACE

One vendor space weekly is dedicated to a non-profit organization that wants to meet with the community. This is an educational opportunity for the customers and vendors. This sponsorship helps cover costs associated, for example tent and table rentals.

CHILDRENS' EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS (SPROUTS ACTIVITY AREA)

Each week the market offers a dedicated children's program. We welcome partners/local businesses to provide activities to teach children and their parents. Examples are events like scavenger hunts, rock painting, fire safety, math skills, and library reading time. Families take a few minutes to stop shopping and spend quality time with their kids. Sponsorship covers costs associated with 24 weeks of activities.

FOOD SHARE MATCH PROGRAM

Our Market believes in offering quality produce to all by offering a match in Food Share dollars. For every dollar a Food Share participant spends at our market, we will match a dollar (up to \$20 per week) to be used for fresh food.

We are proud to be one of only a few markets in Wisconsin who match WIC benefits for children and seniors. 2024 will be the sixth year to offer this outstanding program for low-income customers. Sponsorship covers the cost of the match and related materials associated with this program.

WATER SALES FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITY

Each week, an Oak Creek youth group sells water for \$1 a bottle as a fundraiser. This is open to all Oak Creek organizations of school-age children, including sports teams, best buddies, scouts, etc., giving them the opportunity to raise money and gain communication skills with the public! Sponsorship covers the cost of the water so that they raise 100% of their efforts.

TASTE IT TENT

In 2022, the market introduced a "Taste It Tent" in the center of the square. Each week, volunteers served samples of a local produce item to the market visitors. This was a huge hit, and a great way for patrons to try a fruit or vegetable they'd never had before. This tradition will continue in 2024, and continue to feature healthy options for market-goers to sample! Sponsorship of this tent will offset the costs of the items needed to prepare and serve.

CHILDREN TASTE IT TOKENS

The farmers market offers \$2 tokens free to children each week at the market. They can use these tokens to purchase their own fresh produce. This encourages children to make healthy choices and to get comfortable speaking with the farmers; growing a new generation of market customers. Sponsorship will cover the cost to reimburse the farmers who take the coins

SPECIAL EVENTS

Markets throughout the season offer fun and educational opportunities that are extremely popular, driving additional traffic to the market. Sponsorships are needed to defer the costs and are a great way to get involved.

Events include: Opening Day, Puzzle Exchange, 4th of July, Oak Creek - Meet the Mayor, Chess Day, Pickle Fest,

National Farmers Market Week, Badger Football Opening, Salsa Showdown, and Corn Fest.


