Item 3. Approval of Minutes from February 12, 2020

Item 4. Request to change contingency hire status of probationary officer-Police Department.

Chief Anderson requested permission to change the contingency hire status of Police Officer Maribel Teresi to Probationary Officer.

Item 7. Request to fill full time Firefighter/Paramedic position vacancy due to a retirement

Ald. Gehl made a motion to approve the request to fill a full time Firefighter/Paramedic position vacancy due to a retirement; seconded by Ald. Toman. All aye; motion carries.

Item 8. Request to fill full time Battalion Chief (Operations) position vacancy due to a promotion.

This vacancy was created due to the recent retirement of the Fire Chief and the hiring of internal candidates for replacement of the subsequent positions. If the position cannot be filled internally it will be posted externally.
