SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, August 2020

During the Month of August, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,341 calls. This is a 1% decrease compared to the previous month of July and a 53% decrease compared to August of 2019. 709 incidents came from the East Side, 1,380 came from the West Side, 130 came from the entire city, and 120 were unspecified.

This report will look at the following calls: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Burglaries, Theft, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Thefts

Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 72 reports of PDO during the month of August. This was a 26% increase compared to the month of July. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close, Inattentive Driving, Failure to Control Vehicle, Hit Parked Vehicle, and Unsafe Backing.

19 occurred on the East Side, 40 occurred on the West Side, 2 occurred throughout the Entire City, and 11 were Unspecified.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

Burglaries

There were 6 burglaries that occurred in Oak Creek. This is a 14% decrease compared to the previous month of July. Of the 6 burglaries, 4 were commercial and 2 were residential

<u>Theft</u>

There were 65 thefts during the month of August. This is an 41% increase compared to the previous month of July.

Theft from Vehicle

There were 17 theft from vehicles during the month of August. This is a 51% decrease compared to the previous month of July.

Of the 17 thefts, there were 3 incidents of theft of catalytic converter, and 2 theft of license plates. 6 vehicles were unlocked, 2 were unknown and 2 were locked.

Vehicle Theft

There were 6 vehicle thefts during the month of August. This is a 14% decrease compared to the previous month of July. 1 of the 6 vehicle thefts was done by someone that the owner knew and 2 of the 6 were recovered. 1 of the vehicle thefts reported was a trailer that was taken at a residence driveway and two were cancelled. 2 of the vehicles were taken because vehicle was unlocked and key was in vehicle.





Time of Day Reported




Day of Week Reported

Crash Locations








