SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, October 2020

During the Month of October, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,204 calls. This is a 5% decrease compared to the previous month of September and a 11% decrease compared to October of 2019. 474 incidents came from the East Side, 851 came from the West Side, 84 came from the entire city, 699 came from the city center, and 96 were unspecified.

This report will look at the following calls: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Burglaries, Theft, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Thefts

Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 58 reports of PDO during the month of October. There was no change between the month analyzed and the month of September. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close, Unsafe Backing, Inattentive Driving, Failure to Yield, and Failure to Control Vehicle.

11 occurred on the East Side, 19 occurred on the West Side, 1 occurred throughout the Entire City, 5 were Unspecified and 22 were at the City Center.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

Burglaries

There were 4 burglaries that occurred in Oak Creek. This is a 33% decrease compared to the previous month of September. Of the 4 burglaries, 0 were commercial and 4 were residential. 2 burglaries were done by someone that the person didn't know, 2 homes were entered through window, 1 garage was unlocked/opened, and 1 was entered with a key. None of the burglaries were related to each other.

<u>Theft</u>

There were 74 thefts during the month of October. This is an 48% increase compared to the previous month of September.

There were 33 thefts from vehicles during the month of October. This is an 83% increase compared to the previous month of September.

Of the 33 thefts, there were 2 incidents of theft of catalytic converter, and 2 theft of license plates. 24 vehicles were unlocked, and 5 were locked.

Vehicle Theft






Crash Locations


Burglary Locations:










Theft from Vehicle Locations
