## 2020 Calls for Service and Use of Force

### Calls for Service

Officers interact with citizens in numerous ways. In 2020, we responded to **26,147** calls for service.

### Arrests

Officers took **1434** arrestees into custody in 2020.

### Vehicle Pursuits

Officers were involved in **24** pursuits in 2020. This equates to **0.09%** of the total calls for service.

### Use of Force

Officers were required to use force **69** times in 2020. This equates to **0.26%** of the total calls for service\*.

\*Reported instances are defined as: instances where an arrestee forces an officer to safely initiate physical contact with a subject, control a subject and/or move a subject in a controlled way.

### Hate Crimes

Officers responded to **0** hate crimes in 2020\*.

\*Hate Crime is defined as: threats, harassment, or physical harm and is motivated by prejudice against someone's race, color, religion, national origin, ethnicity, sexual orientation or physical or mental disability.

### Use of Deadly Force

Officers were forced to use such a level of force **0** times in 2020\*.

\*Deadly Force is defined as: The intentional use of a firearm or other instrument, the use of which would result in a high probability of death.
