SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, January 2020

During the Month of January, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,477 calls. This is a 23% increase compared to the previous month of December and an 2% increase compared to January of 2020. 525 incidents came from the East Side, 1,030 came from the West Side, 96 came from the entire city, and 714 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Burglaries, Theft, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Thefts

#### Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 89 reports of PDO during the month of January. This is a 7% increase compared to the previous month of December. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Failure to Yield, Unsafe Backing, Following to Close, Failure to Control Vehicle, and Hit Parked Vehicle.

16 occurred on the East Side, 28 occurred on the West Side, 1 occurred throughout the Entire City, and 33 were at the City Center.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

#### **Burglary**

There was 1 burglary that occurred in Oak Creek. This is a 50% decrease compared to the previous month of December. The burglary occurred in a commercial setting.

#### <u>Theft</u>

There were 48 thefts during the month of January. This is a 7% decrease compared to the previous month of December.

#### Theft from Vehicle

There were 20 thefts from vehicles during the month of January. This is an 233% increase compared to the previous month of December.

Of the 20 thefts, there were 3 reports of stolen license plates, 13 vehicles were unlocked, and 4 were unknown.

#### Vehicle Theft

There were 2 vehicle thefts during the month of January. This is a 33% decrease compared to the previous month of December. 0 of the 2 vehicle thefts were done by someone that the owner knew and 1 of the 2 were recovered.












