

ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS BY HOMEOWNER

Wisconsin Legislature: 101.862(4) (a) dated 04/18/2018 allows the property owner to perform repairs or modifications to the electrical wiring on premises within the portion of the property that the *property owner owns and occupies as a residence without an electrical license.

Requirements:

- A Homeowner Electrical Permit must be obtained and issued prior to the commencement of any electrical work.
- Prior to the concealment of any electrical wiring.
 - All applicable rough electrical inspections such as a trench, in wall, above ceiling, underground, etc. must be performed and passed by the electrical inspector as needed.
- The entire electrical installation shall only be performed by the *property owner.
 - No other person besides the property owner is permitted to cause such installation under an issued Homeowners Electrical Permit.
- The entire electrical installation must comply with the requirements of The State of Wisconsin Electrical Code SPS316 and the current version of The National Electrical Code as adopted by the State of Wisconsin.

I, being the property owner, have read and understand the above statements and do hereby acknowledge the above statements. I hereby assure that I possess the necessary knowledge and skills to properly install the permitted electrical wiring within a safe and workmanship like manner.
