SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, April 2021

During the Month of April, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,170 calls. This is a 13% decrease compared to the previous month of March and a 43% increase compared to April of 2020. 492 incidents came from the East Side, 908 came from the West Side, 101 came from the entire city, and 579 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls for service: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Burglaries, Theft, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Thefts

Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 84 reports of PDO during the month of April. This is a 33% increase compared to the previous month of March. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close, Hit Parked Vehicle, Failure to Yield, Inattentive Driving, and Unsafe Backing.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

Burglary

There were 3 burglaries in Oak Creek during the month of April. This is a 200% increase compared to the previous month of April. 2 of the burglaries happened in a residential area and 1 was in a commercial area.

<u>Theft</u>

There were 56 thefts during the month of April. This is a 55% increase compared to the previous month of March.

Theft from Vehicle

There were 6 thefts from vehicles during the month of April. This is an 14% decrease compared to the previous month of March.

Of the 6 thefts, there was 1 reports of stolen license plates, 1 unlocked vehicle being entered, 1 locked vehicle being entered, and 3 reports of theft of catalytic converters.







Time of Day Reported






Day of Week Reported



Crash Location




Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day




