SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, May 2021

During the Month of May, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,233 calls. This is a 2% increase compared to the previous month of April and a 6% increase compared to May of 2020. 546 incidents came from the East Side, 921 came from the West Side, 105 came from the entire city, and 566 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls for service: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Burglaries, Theft, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Thefts

Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 85 reports of PDO during the month of May. This is a 1% increase compared to the previous month of April. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close, Inattentive Driving, Failure to Yield, Failure to Control Vehicle, and Unsafe Lane Change.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

Burglary

There was 1 burglary in Oak Creek during the month of May. This is a 66% decrease compared to the previous month of April. The burglary happened in a residential area.

Theft

There were 44 thefts during the month of May. This is a 21% decrease compared to the previous month of April.

Theft from Vehicle

There were 4 thefts from vehicles during the month of May. This is an 33% decrease compared to the previous month of April.

Of the 4 thefts, there was 1 report of a stolen license plate, 1 unlocked vehicle being entered, and 2 reports of theft of catalytic converters.

Vehicle Theft

There were 5 vehicle thefts during the month of May. This is a 66% increase compared to the previous month of April. 5 of the 5 vehicles were recovered and 1 of the 5 was done by someone that the owner knew.







Time of Day Reported








Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day








