## Informational and Discussion Items

- Director Jill Lininger provided updates on:
  - O Covid-19 updates: all furniture is in place and staff is organizing layout. Pages are working on it as time allows. Gaming room is still closed as the process for utilizing it is determined and the room is reconfigured. No toys have been placed on the floor. Non-plastic toys will be eliminated due to difficulty cleaning them. All study rooms are open and computers in place. Daily in person patron visits are back to pre-Covid levels.
  - Budget and Revenue: The Oak Creek Public Library Endowment has been established with the Greater Milwaukee Foundation.
  - o Monthly calendar highlights: programming will remain virtual throughout the summer. Story time will resume in person in fall with one virtual option and registration will be required.
