Item 3. Approval of minutes from 06/23/2021

Ald. Gehl made a motion to approve the minutes of 06/23/2021, seconded by Ald. Duchniak. Ald. Toman abstained, all aye; motion carried.

<u>Item 4.</u> Discuss the Police and Fire Department Wage Compression Survey issued by the City to seven (7) Municipalities.

Discussion for this topic focused on the compression of wages between command staff and the non-command staff. HR Manager Rogers and ACA Gagin provided information on a possible reason for this compression, low paid command staff in relation to similar position holders in and adjacent to Milwaukee County. Gagin informed the group that the difference in how gun allowance is handled has and will lead to compression as well. The members of the Committee noted this issue will have large impacts on the operating budget, so they would like the larger Council to be brought in and desire for the next budget to consider this issue, even if the recommended changes to pay structure need to take place over time. The length of the current collective bargaining agreement was discussed as a potential time line for making incremental changes to address the issue.

Ald. Toman made a motion to adjourn at 1:34 P.M., seconded by Ald. Gehl. All aye; motion carried.
