LIBRARY BOARD MINUTES NOVEMBER 11, 2021

 - o Covid-19 updates: None
 - Budget and revenue: Most of the annual budget for book purchases has been spent. Using material replacement budget to replace books that have been weeded from the collection.
 - Monthly staff report highlights: Staff has been invited to purchase library logo clothing. Created a form for "Consideration of Donated Works by Local and Self-published Authors" to allow staff to evaluate books to be added to the library's collection. A copy of the completed form and book are required. Fall Fest was very successful for both the Friends and library. The book sale earned \$575.
