## Landfill License

License Year: Calendar  
Municipal Code Section 13.20 – 13.27

Required when moving 1000 yards or more of landfill

To apply for a landfill license, applicant must:

- Complete application, including signature
- Application must be accompanied by a cash bond for surety bond in a sum not less than \$10,000, certified by the City Engineer, for the purpose of securing the City against any and all damages.
- Applicant must submit a topographic map prepared by Wisconsin State registered Professional Engineer (Sec. 13.25(a)(9))
- Pay license fee

In addition to the above, the following Engineering permit is required:

- Erosion Control Permit
- Permit fee

Submit landfill license application and fee to the City Clerk's office

Submit erosion control permit application and fee to the Engineering office
