- 1. Welcome/Call to order Commissioner Jim Ruetz called the meeting to order at 9:36 a.m.
- 2. Approval of minutes September 13, 2021 meeting Commissioner Ken Gehl made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 13, 2021 meeting. Commissioner Kim Jankowski seconded the motion. All were in favor.

## 3. New Business

- Proposed Dates for 2022 Event Season
  - Laura Nelson outlined the dates for several of the Events for the 2022 season.
    - o The dates for the Farmers Market will be the Saturdays from June 4<sup>th</sup> to October 22<sup>nd</sup>.
    - o The Food Truck Tour will be Wednesdays, June 29<sup>th</sup>, July 27<sup>th</sup>, August 31<sup>st</sup>, and September 28<sup>th</sup>.
    - The OC Beer Gardens will be June 16-18<sup>th</sup>, July 14-16<sup>th</sup>, August 18-20<sup>th</sup>, and September 15-17<sup>th</sup>.
  - o There was discussion about the Dog Days event coinciding with the Farmers Market. Some of the Market vendors have complained that they do not do as much business when the two events happen at the same time. Other venues were discussed as well as timing and setting up the space differently.
  - The decision was made that Dog Days will remain the weekend of July 23<sup>rd</sup>, in Drexel Town Square.
  - Laura suggested pairing the Food Truck night with Movie Night. The consensus was, the June 29<sup>th</sup> Food Truck night will be a Movie Night, to test the waters, and then a decision will be made regarding the Aug. 31<sup>st</sup> date, based on the feedback.
  - o Discussion on the date of the CAFÉ event was tabled till the next meeting.
  - o Fall Fest will take place the weekend of October 22<sup>nd</sup>.
  - Laura is still working on this year's Winter Event. She is hoping to have an Olympics watch party, pop up beer garden, Curling and at least two other sports provide demos. The tentative date is February 19<sup>th</sup>. The Winter Event for 2022 will be discussed after this year's event has taken place.
  - Commissioner Ken Gehl voiced a desire to have more music events.

## Ad Space in the Chamber of Commerce Oak Creek/Franklin Guide
