## LIBRARY BOARD MINUTES DECEMBER 9, 2021

- Director Jill Lininger provided updates on:
  - o Covid-19 updates: None
  - Budget and revenue: Tracking well on annual budget. The 3D printer no longer works and is not able to be repaired. Plan to buy a commercial grade printer.
  - o Monthly staff report highlights: WILS is working with Kanopy on behalf of Wisconsin libraries for on demand video services. Several MCFLS libraries have it and others are considering. MCFLS ARPA funding is being allocated to cover the BrainFuse database for 2022. The application is in process. The funding is also being used to purchase lockers for after-hours pick-ups by patrons. There are several open staff positions. One desk clerk position has been filled, but a second desk clerk, part time youth services librarian and part time page position are open for applications. The upholstered chairs will be cleaned along with the carpeting in late December/early January.
