Farmers Market Proposal

- O Dawn Carrillo made a presentation to the Commissioners regarding the future of the Farmers Market. She proposed having a 24-week market that will include 4 Saturdays in May. Starting the Market in May will allow farmers to sell popular products at a high dollar value that would be missed if the market were to start in June.
- \$10,000 has been secured for sponsorship of the WIC/SNAP program.
- An increase from \$15,000 to \$18,000 for Farmers Market Manager salary was requested to accommodate work involved for the 4 extra weeks if they are added.
- Commissioner Jim Ruetz moved to approve the addition of 4 Farmers Markets on the following dates: May 7, May 14, May 20, and May 28, with and increased salary of \$18,000 for Dawn Carrillo commensurate with the additional time and planning. The \$3,000 increase in salary is contingent upon the vendor fulfillment of the additional 4 weeks to the satisfaction of the Commission. Alderman Ken Gehl seconded the motion. All were in favor.
