SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, Entire Year of 2021

During the entire year of 2021, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 27,583 calls. This is a 5% increase compared to the previous year. 6,411 incidents came from the East Side, 11,960 were from the West Side, and 7,909 were from the City Center. The East Side saw a 2% increase. The West Side saw a 16% increase, and the City Center saw an 8% increase compared to the previous year of 2021.

This yearly report will look at the following calls for service: PDO, Burglaries, Theft, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Theft.

#### **Property Damage MV Accident (PDO)**

There were 949 reports of PDO during the entire year of 2021. This is a 14% decrease compared to the previous year of 2020. The top five contributing factors for crashes are listed from greatest to least: Following too Close (136), Failure to Yield (128), Inattentive Driving (95), Failure to Control Vehicle (71), and Unsafe Turn (35)

181 happened in the East Side, 332 in the West Side, and 401 in the City Center. There was a 15% increase in the East Side, the West Side saw a 23% increase, and the City Center saw an 84% increase compared to the previous year of 2020.

There were 3 fatal accidents during the year 2021.

#### **Burglaries**

There was a total of 30 Burglaries during the entire year of 2021. This is a 34% decrease compared to the previous year of 2020. The East Side saw a 27% decrease, and the West Side saw a 66% increase compared to the previous year of 2020.

Of the 30 burglaries, 13 were residential, and 17 were commercial areas. Residential burglaries saw a 16% decrease, and commercial burglary saw a 60% increase compared to 2020. There were 4 forced entries and 6 non-forced entries into residential areas. The main entrance into homes is by unlocked/opened windows.

#### **Theft**

There were 536 thefts during the entire year of 2021. This is a 13% decrease compared to the previous year of 2020. 126 happened on the East Side, 213 happened on the West Side, 280 happened in the City Center. The East Side saw a 37% decrease, the West Side saw a 53% decrease, and the City Center saw a 266% increase compared to the previous year of 2020.

In addition, there were 33 thefts from homes, 50 thefts from person(s), 35 employee thefts, 20 package thefts, 13 theft from hotels, 2 theft from trailers, and 2 theft of city property. Total retail thefts in Oak Creek were 367 thefts.

#### **Theft from Vehicle**

There were 133 thefts from vehicles during the entire year of 2021. This is a 28% decrease compared to the previous year of 2020. 33 happened on the East Side, 60 happened on the West Side, and 39 in the City Center. The East Side saw a 43% decrease. The West Side saw a 9% increase, and the City Center saw a 45% decrease compared to 2020.

In 2021, 64% of the vehicles entered without consent happened because the vehicle was unlocked. 22% of the locked vehicles were opened forcefully, and 14% were unknown. There was 55 theft of catalytic converter and 15 license plates taken in 2021. Catalytic converter theft increased by 89% since 2020.

#### **Vehicle Theft**

There were 62 Vehicle Thefts during the entire year of 2021. This is a 3% increase compared to the previous year of 2020. 9 happened on the East Side, 41 happened on the West Side, and 12 in the City Center. The East Side Saw an 18% decrease, the West Side saw a 24% increase, and the City Center saw a 25% decrease compared to 2020.

23 of the vehicle thefts were done in residential areas, and 24 were in commercial areas. 11 of the vehicle thefts were caused by someone the victim knew and 36 were unknown. 34% of the vehicle thefts were caused because the owner left their key inside the vehicle while unlocked. 36% of all vehicle thefts were non-forced in 2021.





Type of Burglary





## Theft Locations











#### Vehicle Theft










