

Oak Creek Police & Fire Commission Meeting Minutes

Item One: Call Meeting to Order

President Scott Koenig called the meeting of the Oak Creek Police and Fire Commission to order on Thursday, August 4, 2022, at 1801 hours at the Oak Creek City Hall, 8040 S. 6th Street, Oak Creek, WI.

Item Two: Roll Call

The following Commissioners were present: Jesus Carrillo, Margo Franklin, Gene Hibbler, Scott Koenig and Jeff Sageser. Also in attendance was Lieutenant Andrew Thorne from the Oak Creek Police Department.

Item Three: Approval of Minutes

Commissioner Hibbler made a motion to approve the minutes from our previous meeting (731) on July 14, 2022. Commissioner Koenig seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Commissioners present voted aye, and the motion carried at 1803 hours.

Item Four: Election of Officers (Moved to End of Meeting)

Commissioner Koenig made a motion to elect Commissioner Sageser as Secretary of the Police and Fire Commission. Commissioner Hibbler seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Commissioners present voted aye, and the motion carried at 1831 hours.

Commissioner Franklin made a motion to elect Commissioner Hibbler as President of the Police and Fire Commission. Commissioner Koenig seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Commissioners present voted aye, and the motion carried at 1832 hours.

Item Five: Convene into Closed Session

Commissioner Koenig made a motion to convene into Closed Session pursuant to Wisconsin State Statutes, Section 19.85(1)(c) to consider employment and performance evaluation data of police officer candidates. Commissioner Carrillo seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Commissioners present voted aye, and the

motion carried at 1803 hours. The following Commissioners were in attendance: Jesus Carrillo, Margo Franklin, Genene Hibbler, Scott Koenig and Jeff Sageser. Also in attendance was Lieutenant Andrew Thorne from the Oak Creek Police Department.

Item Six: Reconvene into Open Session

Item Seven: Take Action on Police Officer Candidates
