SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, December 2022

During the month of December, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,033 calls for service. This is a 5% decrease compared to the previous month of November, and a 3% decrease compared to December of 2021. 432 incidents came from the East Side, 842 came from the West Side, and 673 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls for service: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Theft, Burglary, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Thefts

#### **Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)**

There were 88 reports of PDO during the month of December. This is a 12% decrease compared to the previous month of November. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close, Failure to Control Vehicle, Inattentive Driving, Failure to Yield, and Unsafe Lane Change.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

#### **Theft**

There were 84 thefts during the month of December. This is a 55% increase compared to the previous month of November.

#### **Burglary**

There were 2 burglaries during the month of December. There is no change between months. Both burglaries were at a commercial area.

#### **Theft from Vehicle**

There were 3 thefts from vehicles during the month of December. This is a 40% decrease compared to the previous month of November. Of the 3 thefts, 1 locked vehicle was entered, 1 unlocked vehicle was entered, and a catalytic converter was removed from a vehicle.






**Top 5 Cause for Crash** 



# **Time of Day Reported**




### **Day of Week Reported**










