CALLS FOR SERVICE AND USE OF FORCE

2021

Calls for Service:

Officers interact with citizens in numerous ways. In 2021, we responded to **27,583** calls for service.

Arrests:

Officers took **979** arrestees into custody in 2021

Vehicle Pursuits:

Officers were involved in **17** pursuits in 2021. This equates to **0.09%** of the total calls for service.

Use of Force:

Officers were required to use force **56** times in 2021. This equates to **0.20%** of the total calls for service.

Reported instances are defined as: instances where an arrestee forces an officer to safely initiate physical contact with a subject, control a subject and/or move a subject in a controlled way.

Use of Deadly Force:

Officers were forced to use such a level of force **1** time in 2021.

Deadly Force is defined as: The intentional use of a firearm or other instrument, the use of which would result in a high probability of death.

Hate Crimes:

Officers responded to **0** hate crimes in 2021

Hate Crime is defined as: threats, harassment, or physical harm and is motivated by prejudice against someone's race, color, religion, national origin, ethnicity, sexual orientation or physical or mental disability.
