SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, February 2023

During the month of February, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,162 calls for service. This is an 8% decrease compared to the previous month of January, and a 11% increase compared to February of 2022. 472 incidents came from the East Side, 938 came from the West Side, and 666 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls for service: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Theft, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Thefts

Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 47 reports of PDO during the month of February. This is a 47% decrease compared to the previous month of January. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close, Failure to Control Vehicle, Failure to Yield, Inattentive Driving, and Red-Light Violation.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

Theft

There were 47 thefts during the month of February. This is a 42% decrease compared to the previous month of January.

Theft from Vehicle

There were 8 thefts from vehicles during the month of February. This is a 300% increase compared to the previous month of January. Of the 8 thefts, 6 catalytic converters were stolen, 1 license plate was removed from a vehicle, and 1 locked vehicle was forcefully entered.

Vehicle Theft

There were 6 vehicle thefts during the month of February. This is a 20% increase compared to the previous month of February. Of the six vehicle thefts, 3 were residential and 3 were commercial.










Time of Day Reported












Crash Locations:



PDO Heat Chart by Area:




Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day





Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day






