## LIBRARY BOARD MINUTES MARCH 9, 2023

## The City's Vision

The Oak Creek Public Library Board met on Thursday, March 9, 2023. Those present were Stephanie Matthews, Jill Meyer, Carol Sagan, Karen Umbs and Jill Lininger. Sharon Armstrong, Pamela Aiken and Greg Loreck were excused. Umbs called the meeting to order at 5:02p.m.

There was no public comment.

## **New Business**

- A motion was made by Sagan and seconded by Matthews to approve the minutes of February 9, 2023. Motion carried.
- A motion was made by Meyer and seconded by Matthews to approve the February 2023 vendor summary in the amount of \$117,399.20. Motion carried.
- A motion was made by Umbs and seconded by Sagan to close the library on Wednesday, April 12 for staff inservice. Motion carried.
- A motion was made by Umbs and seconded by Sagan to approve the purchase of a 1-year subscription to the online video streaming service, Kanopy. Motion carried.
- A motion was made by Umbs and seconded by Sagan to approve setting the fine threshold to \$10 for the use of library materials based on a final decision from MCFLS member libraries. Motion carried.

## Informational and Discussion Items

- Director Jill Lininger provided updates on:
  - Monthly staff report highlights: Seventy people came to the gaming room grand opening.
     Reservations are averaging five people per day. More games were purchased due to high usage rates.
     Author Ellie Marney reached out to Rachel and Mary about participating in their June podcast in conjunction with the release of her new book.
  - o Monthly calendar highlights: August 20<sup>th</sup> will be Oak Creek Library night at the Milwaukee Milkmen game. The Friends will receive \$3 for every ticket sold. There will be a raffle, giveaways and an interview highlighting the library between innings. More details will be forthcoming.
