SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, April 2023

During the month of April, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,400 calls for service. This is an 4% increase compared to the previous month of March, and a 8% increase compared to April of 2022. 564 incidents came from the East Side, 990 came from the West Side, and 721 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls for service: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Theft, Burglary, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Theft.

Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 75 reports of PDO during the month of April. This is a 7% decrease compared to the previous month of March. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close, Inattentive Driving, Failure to Yield, Unsafe Lane Change, and Red-Light Violation.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

Theft

There were 50 thefts during the month of April. This is a 19% decrease compared to the previous month of March.

Burglary

There were 2 burglaries during the month of April. There was no change between months. Both burglaries were at commercial areas.

Theft from Vehicle

There were 3 thefts from vehicles during the month of April. This is a 50% decrease compared to the previous month of March. Of the three thefts, two vehicles were entered forcefully, and one license plate was stolen.

Vehicle Theft

There were 4 vehicle thefts during the month of April. This is a 42% decrease compared to the previous month of April. Of the four vehicle thefts, 1 was residential and 3 were commercial areas.








Time of Day Reported








PDO Heat Chart by Area (April):



Count by Month and Day of Month
















Theft Heat Chart by Area:

Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day









