

SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, June 2023

During the month of June, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,652 calls for service. This is an 2% decrease compared to the previous month of May, and a 16% increase compared to June of 2022. 646 incidents came from the East Side, 1,097 came from the West Side, and 801 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls for service: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Theft, Burglary, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Theft.

Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 82 reports of PDO during the month of June. This is a 6% increase compared to the previous month of May. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close, Inattentive Driving, Failure to Yield, Unsafe Turn, and Failure to Control Vehicle.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

Theft

There were 47 thefts during the month of June. This is a 21% decrease compared to the previous month of May.

Burglary


There was 2 burglary during the month of June. This is a 100% increase compared to the previous month of May. This was a residential burglary.

Theft from Vehicle

There were 4 thefts from vehicles during the month of June. This is a 63% decrease compared to the previous month of May. Of the four thefts, 2 locked vehicles were forcefully entered, 1 unlocked/opened vehicle was entered, and 1 vehicle had gas siphoned out of vehicle.







Day of Week Reported




Time of Day Reported








PDO and PI Heat Chart by Area (June):



Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day





Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day







(Retail Theft Only) Day of Week Reported




(Retail Theft Only) Time of Day Reported






Change in Thefts (2023)



Theft Heat Chart by Area:



Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day




