1. Roll Call: Present: Chairperson K. Kolhouse, Commissioner C. Kolhouse, Commissioner M. Guse, Commissioner T. Rufer, Commissioner K. Maggard, Commissioner R. Atwood, Commissioner C. Schaack. Excused Absent: Commissioner C. Francisco, Commissioner R. Maggard.

2. Discuss 4th of July Event.

- a. Commissioner R. Atwood confirmed setup for ice cream at the American Legion.
- b. Commission reviewed parade staging and line up which begins at 7:30 a.m. Participants asked to arrive no later than 8:30 a.m.
- c. Commission agreed to meet at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, July 3rd to set up picnic tables at Lake Vista Park.
- d. Commission agreed to meet 6:30 p.m. on Monday July 3rd at parade route for parade lineup stake pounding. Members encouraged to bring hammers.
- e. Chairperson K. Kolhouse reported that port-a-potties will be delivered on Monday July 3rd.
- f. Chairperson K. Kolhouse gave a review of parade line up route.
- g. Commissioner C. Schaack reported that volunteers will be arriving at 7 a.m. at the Community Center on July 4th.
- h. Commission noted that the Oak Creek City website has the wrong parade route map.
- i. Commissioner C. Francisco sent report that we have seventy-four total participants.
- j. Commission made plans for next year to reach out to more participants and split up the work amongst Commission members.
- k. Commissioner R. Atwood recommended next year to make signs about shuttle that hang out the bus window during the parade to advertise the shuttle to the fireworks.
- I. Commissioner R. Atwood suggested a bike decorating contest and have them join the parade for 2024.
- m. Chairperson K. Kolhouse suggested a pet parade, but Commissioner R. Atwood says maybe too hot for animals to walk in a parade.
- n. Commissioner M. Guse asked about sponsorship banner for float. Chairperson K. Kolhouse reports that he will get a banner.
- o. Commissioner C. Francisco will deliver flags to Rob at Lions Club on Monday July 3rd to pass out at the parade.
- p. Food trucks set up at 4 p.m. on July 4th. Chairperson K. Kolhouse recommended that we require a license and \$20 fee along with insurance when requesting food trucks for 2024.
- q. Band at Lake Vista Park on July 4th starting at 5 p.m., set up at 4:30 p.m. Scheduled to play from 5-8 p.m.
- r. Chairperson K. Kolhouse reported 2600 glow sticks have been ordered and will be passed out during the fireworks.

- s. Commissioner M. Guse was unable to confirm lemonade stand participation for the fireworks event.
- t. Chairperson K. Kolhouse scheduled 2 shuttle buses 4-9 p.m. and 7 total shuttle buses 9 p.m. end of night.
