

SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, September 2023

During the month of September, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,152 calls for service. This is an 10% decrease compared to the previous month of August, and a 6% decrease compared to September of 2022. 488 incidents came from the East Side, 886 came from the West Side, and 663 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls for service: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Theft, Burglary, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Theft.

Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 69 reports of PDO during the month of September. This is a 22% decrease compared to the previous month of August. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close, Failure to Yield, Failure to Control Vehicle, Inattentive Driving, and Unsafe Turn.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

Theft

There were 40 thefts during the month of September. This is a 43% decrease compared to the previous month of August.

Burglary


There were 2 burglaries during the month of September. This is a 100% increase compared to the previous month of August.

There were 9 theft from vehicles during the month of September. This is a 125% increase compared to the previous month of August. All vehicles entered were unlocked/opened.




Top 5 Cause for Crash



Day of Week Reported




Time of Day Reported







Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day





Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day





Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day



(Retail Theft Only) Day of Week Reported




(Retail Theft Only) Time of Day Reported




