4. Health Department Updates
 - Immunization Program overview – A. Barberena provided an overview of Health Department immunization activities, programming, and grants.
 - D. DuBois, Health Officer, provided update on Health Department activities.
 - Draft budget has been submitted; Council will review and finalized in November
 - Working with Library to offer New Parent group; hoping to begin in early 2024
 - Partnering with Police Department and Froedtert to host medication collection event at Farmer's market on 9/9/23
 - Partnered with Fire Department to have harm reduction vending machine placed at Fire Station 3. Machine contains Narcan, Fentanyl test strips, medication lock bags, medication disposal bags, and gun locks
 - Seeing increase in COVID cases; will expect case counts to be higher in fall and winter seasons, similar to influenza
 - Planning for flu and COVID vaccine clinics this fall

 - Inspections going well. Processing several new licenses or changes in ownership for businesses.
