b) City Marketing and Public Relations Department Creation.

Andrew discussed the creation of a Marketing and Public Relations Department with the Commissioners.

- Making a substantial investment in marketing and public relation in the city.
- Create an employer brand- recognize city employees for the work that is done, demonstrating the value to the public.
- Building up community promotion.
- Not a communication strategy alone- also an Economic Development and Tourism strategy for the city.
- Broadened definition of Tourism- promote the community to bring people here.
- Create partnership including financial involvement with the Tourism Commission and DTS Owners Association.
- Commissioners discussed the benefits of buying into in-house marketing versus an outside firm.
