



### Cart Placement

- The arrows on the lid of the cart must point to the street
- Handles and wheels should face away from the street
- The garbage cart should be placed within 2 ft. of the street on one side of the driveway
- The recycle cart should be placed within 2 ft. of the street on the other side of the driveway
- Please keep 3 ft. of clearance between the carts and other objects, especially mailboxes and vehicles

### Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

- Reduce paper waste by using both sides of the paper and using scrap paper whenever possible
- When shopping, reuse canvas, paper or plastic bags to bring home purchases
- Recycle as much waste as you can by following these guidelines

Recycling collection is every other week.

Please place the following items in your recycle cart:

### Mixed Containers

- Aluminum cans and clean aluminum foil
- Tin cans and steel cans
- Glass bottles and jars, etc.
- #1-7 plastic
- Milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons, etc.

### Mixed Paper

- Newspaper, magazines, books, mail, school/ office paper, envelopes, etc.
- Brown corrugated cardboard
- Cereal and shoe boxes
- Paper bags

Please do not put recycling in plastic bags. Local clean sweep programs may offer alternative options for disposal of fluorescent light bulbs, household hazardous waste, pharmaceuticals, and electronics.

### DO NOT put the following items in the recycle cart:

- Styrofoam of any kind
- Trash
- Construction material
- Clothing
- Yard waste
- Household hazardous waste
- Electronics
- Shredded paper



If a household unit requires an additional container for trash or recycling, please contact GFL directly to arrange for payment. Rate is the same that is charged to the City, on an annualized basis.
