  - O Budget and revenue: There is a small carryover from 2023. Various items are starting to wear out. Will need to consider a plan for replacement of some items each year. We have been approved for another WAICU intern. Our children's department intern from last year is returning. MCLFS is working on a strategic plan for 2025 2027. Member agreements expire at the end of 2024.
  - Monthly staff report highlights: Two new desk clerks started on Monday. Two other positions just closed. The wage increases have increased the number of applications. The wall manipulations for the DECA project have arrived. Planning on a ribbon cutting before the friends meeting on April 10<sup>th</sup> at 6pm. MCFLS is implementing a new card catalog in Spring. Rachel is coordinating. February is Love Your Library month. Offering food for fines and fun activities for people to do.
