SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, Entire Year of 2023

In 2023, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 27,974 calls for service. This is a 5% increase compared to the previous year of 2022. 6,319 reports came from the East Side, 11,697 were from the West Side, and 8,662 were from the City Center.

This yearly report will look at the following calls for service: PDO, Burglary, Theft, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Theft.

Property Damage MV Accident (PDO)

There were 991 reports of PDO during 2023. This is a 3% increase compared to the previous year of 2022. The top five contributing factors for crashes are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close (161), Failure to Yield (101), Inattenitive Driving (96), Failure to Control Vehicle (82), and Unsafe Lane Change (52).

There was 1 fatal accident during 2023. This is a 75% decrease compared to the previous year of 2022. Maps were produced to examine where there were high density's per area. In addition, each of the areas were split to show the time of day and day of week of when car crashes were more prominent. Area 2 and 3 were split into two to show north and south of Puetz Rd, and Area 4 was split to show North and South of Forest Hill. The purpose of this, was to dive deeper into areas where hotspots may go unseen, and to examine the areas through a lens where car accidents happen more frequently.

Burglary

There were 17 Burglaries during 2023. This is a 26% decrease compared to the previous year of 2022.

Of the 17 burglaries, 5 were residential, and 12 were commercial areas. Residential burglaries saw a 54% decrease compared to 2022. There was no change between years for commercial burglaries. There were 12 forced entries into commercial areas, and 5 non-forced entries into residential areas. The main entrance into homes was by unlocked/opened windows and doors. Burglaries that were committed at commercial areas were at conctronstion projects, gas stations, and/or auto dealerships.

<u>Theft</u>

There were 669 thefts during 2023. This is a 1% increase compared to the previous year of 2022. 19 happened on the East Side, 233 happened on the West Side, 416 happened in the City Center. The East Side saw an 81% decrease, the West Side saw a 4% increase, and the City Center saw a 27% increase compared to the previous year of 2022.

The total retail thefts in Oak Creek was 458 thefts. This is a 2% decrease in retail thefts compared to the previous year of 2022. In addition, there were 32 thefts from homes, 45 thefts from person(s), 100 employee thefts, 18 package thefts, and 5 theft from hotel/motel rooms.

Theft from Vehicle

There were 91 theft from vehicles during 2023. This is a 41% decrease compared to the previous year of 2022. 18 happened on the East Side, 47 happened on the West Side, and 26 in the City Center. The East Side saw a 30% decrease, the West Side saw a 50% decrease, and the City Center saw a 23% decrease compared to 2022. 39% of thefts occurred in a commercial area and 61% of thefts occurred in a residential area.

In 2023, 74% of the vehicles entered without consent happened because the vehicle was unlocked/opened. 25% of locked vehicles were entered forcefully, and 1% were classified as unknown. In addition, there were 9 theft of catalytic converter, and 12 theft of license plates in 2023. Catalytic converter theft decreased by approx. 83% compared to 2022.

Vehicle Theft

There were 60 reports of Vehicle Thefts during 2023. This is a 27% decrease compared to 2022. 8 happened on the East Side, 59 happened on the West Side, and 20 happened in the City Center. The East Side saw a 11% decrease, the West Side saw a 45% decrease, and the City Center saw a 33% increase compared to 2022. 10 were cancelled and required no police assistance.

Of the 50 reportedly stolen vehicles, 22 happened in a residential area, and 26 happened in a commercial area. In addition, 3 rental tucks were not returned and classified as a theft, and 10 were accidently misplaced. 11 of the vehicle thefts were taken by someone the victim knew and 32 were unknown. Of the 50 vehicle thefts, 64% were taken with keys. 68% of all vehicle thefts were non-forced entry, 30% were forced entry, and 2% were classified as unknown entry.











PDO & PI | Comparison of 2022 & 2023






Car Crash Hotspot Analysis by Area: Area 2






Car Crash Hotspot Analysis by Area: Area 3








Burglary Locations








Burglary Location | 2023















Theft | Comparison 2022 & 2023






Theft from Vehicle | 2023












Theft from Vehicle | Comparison 2022 & 2023






Vehicle Theft | 2023
