

SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, March 2023

During the month of March, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,043 calls for service. This is an 3% increase compared to the previous month of February, and an 11% decrease compared to March of 2023. 455 reports came from the East Side, 880 came from the West Side, and 598 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls for service: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Theft, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Theft.

Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 53 reports of PDO during the month of March. This is a 15% decrease compared to the previous month of February. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Failure to Yield, Inattentive Driving, Side Swipe, Following to Close, and Unsafe Lane Change.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

Theft

There were 52 thefts during the month of March. This is a 13% increase compared to the previous month of February.

Theft from Vehicle

There were 14 theft from vehicles during the month of March. This is a 133% increase compared to the previous month of February. Of the 14 thefts, 7 locked vehicles were forcefully entered, 4 unlocked/opened vehicle were entered, 2 license plates were stolen, and 1 catalytic converter was removed from a vehicle.

Vehicle Theft

There were 6 vehicle thefts during the month of March. This is a 50% increase compared to the previous month of February.






Top 5 Cause for Crash

Time of Day Reported






Crash Locations:







PDO and PI Heat Chart by Area (March):



Count by Day and Hour




Area 3:

Count by Day and Hour





Count by Day and Hour



(Retail Theft Only) Time of Day Reported







Retail Theft Locations:






