SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, July 2024

During the month of July, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,416 calls for service. This is an 8% increase compared to the previous month of June, and a 2% decrease compared to July of 2023. 589 reports came from the East Side, 1,016 came from the West Side, and 709 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls for service: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Theft, and Theft from Vehicle. There were no vehicle thefts during this month.

### **Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)**

There were 87 reports of PDO during the month of July. This is a 12% increase compared to the previous month of June. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Following to Close, Unsafe Turn, Inattentive Driving, Failure to Yield, and Failure to Control Vehicle.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

### **Theft**

There were 42 thefts during the month of July. This is a 2% increase compared to the previous month of June.

### **Theft from Vehicle**

There were 17 theft from vehicles during the month of July. This is a 142% increase compared to the previous month of June. Of the 17 thefts, 5 locked vehicles were forcefully entered, 8 unlocked/opened vehicle were entered, and 2 license plates were removed, 1 catalytic converter was removed, and 1 hood was removed from a vehicle.






### Top 5 Cause for Crash



### Day of Week Reported






### Crash Locations:

Change in PDO and PI







### PDO and PI Heat Chart by Area Q3 (7/1-7/31/2024):







(Retail Theft Only) Day of Week Reported




(Retail Theft Only) Time of Day Reported







### Retail Theft Locations:

Change in Retail Thefts






