

SUBJECT: Crime Analysis Report, August 2024

During the month of August, the Oak Creek Police Department responded to 2,416 calls for service. This is an 8% increase compared to the previous month of July, and a 2% decrease compared to August of 2023. 572 reports came from the East Side, 1,021 came from the West Side, and 641 came from the city center.

This report will look at the following calls for service: Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accidents, Theft, Theft from Vehicle, and Vehicle Theft.

Property Damage Motor Vehicle Accident (PDO)

There were 24 reports of PDO during the month of August. This is a 24% decrease compared to the previous month of July. The top five contributing factors are listed from greatest to least: Failure to Yield, Following to Close, Inattentive Driving, Failure to Control Vehicle, and Unsafe Turn.

There were no fatal accidents during this month.

Theft

There were 54 thefts during the month of August. This is a 28% increase compared to the previous month of July.

Theft from Vehicle


There were 13 theft from vehicles during the month of August. This is a 23% decrease compared to the previous month of July. Of the 13 thefts 9 unlocked/opened vehicles were entered, 2 license plates were removed, and 1 report of multiple semi-trucks being entered and the CPC (Common Power Control module) removed from trucks.

Vehicle Theft

There were 3 vehicle thefts during the month of August. There was no change in thefts compared to the previous month of July. 1 of the vehicles reported as stolen was a rental and 1 was a stolen trailer.






Top 5 Cause for Crash

Time of Day Reported










PDO and PI Heat Chart by Area Q3 (7/1-8/31/2024):



Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day




Area 3:

Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day





Count by Day of Week and Hour of Day




Retail Theft

(Retail Theft Only) Day of Week Reported







Retail Theft Locations:









Theft from Vehicle Entire Year




Places of Theft from Vehicle Entire Year
