**Recommendation**: That the Common Council approve the use of *Wisconsin Surplus* for on-line auction services to dispose of surplus city property.

**Background**: In the last quarter of 2015 City Hall, Fire station #1, and the City Library will be moving to new locations Current City Policy (Purchasing Policy) Article 9 *Disposal of Surplus Goods* authorizes city surplus property to be disposed of "through sealed bids, auction, or open market sales".

City Staff will be conducting an inventory of all goods no longer useable. Staff has researched the on-line auction services provided by Wisconsin Surplus, for disposal of surplus property. Wisconsin Surplus markets all surplus property, posts the property on their auction site, and ensures pick up of the property to the final high bidder. Wisconsin Surplus also invoices and receipts all purchasers.

Wisconsin Surplus is currently used by 52,000 registered users, receives 2.5 million views, and increases its users by 100 per week.

**Fiscal Impact**: There would be no cost charged by Wisconsin Surplus to the City. Purchasers pay Wisconsin Surplus directly for their fee. The City will receive the full amount paid for an item. The use of Wisconsin Surplus allows the City to potentially realize the fullest value for surplus inventory with very little administrative overhead.

# **Surplus Management Plan**

#### **Surplus Management**

### **Objective**

The purpose of the Oak Creek Surplus Management Plan is to dispose of City Inventory no longer needed as the transition to new City buildings occurs.

The efficient management of inventory is essential. A municipality's record of surplus is also of concern to its citizens who have a financial interest in the City. Key goals are defined by two determinations; comply with legal requirements for City property disposal and to receive maximum value for each public dollar spent.

To achieve the highest result, an inventory of surplus must be created, organized, and disposed of systematically. Simply, the disposal process has three goals:

- 1. Full realization of the value of goods.
- 2. All surplus is disposed of to the economic advantage of the City.
- 3. Process utilizes sealed bids, auction and/or open market sales.

#### Inventory

Inventory will need to be conducted on all materials for auction in City Hall, Library and Fire Station #1. This work can proceed prior to a firm completion date for new buildings being determined. Inventory will include existing location, intent to use at new building, full description, price and picture. Once all inventory is complete, the team will need a date to begin auction.

### **City Surplus Transfer**

Purpose: The purpose of this easement is to install, operate, maintain repair, replace and extend underground utility facilities, pipeline or pipelines with valves, tieovers, main laterals and service laterals, together with all necessary and appurtenant equipment under and above ground, including cathodic protection apparatus used for corrosion control, as deemed necessary by Grantee, for the transmission and distribution of natural gas and all by-products thereof, or any liquids, gases, or substances which can or may be transported or distributed through a pipeline, including the customary growth and replacement thereof. Trees, bushes, branches and roots may be trimmed or removed so as not to interfere with Grantee's use of the easement area.
- Access: Grantee or its agents shall have the right to enter and use Grantor's land with full right of ingress and egress over and across the easement area and adjacent lands of Grantor for the purpose of exercising its rights in the easement area.
