Not more than twelve (12) amusement device registrations shall be granted to any person for operation or use in a single premises. Any premise containing more than twelve (12) amusement devices shall be subject to Municipal Code Section 7.21 regulating arcades.

Per WI State Statute, Section 945.01(3)(a), "A gambling machine is a contrivance which for a consideration affords the player an opportunity to obtain something of value, the award of which is determined by chance, even though accompanied by some skill and whether or not the prize is automatically paid by the machine."

Per WI State Statute, Section 945.03(1m) commercial gambling, except as noted in Section 945.03(2m), is a Class I felony.
